

ALFRETON GOLF CLUB - BUGGY POLICY

The policy of the Golf Club is to allow players to use a buggy if they are unable to complete 18 holes of golf without the use of a buggy. Members must first obtain the permission of the Secretary or the Chairman of the Greens Committee. They should give an assurance that they have the skill to operate a buggy and will be fully accountable for their actions. They must also sign a Safety Acknowledgement form before being allowed on the Course with a buggy and have a valid insurance to cover liability for risks to third parties. Players must follow the route specified by the Club.

Visitors must give prior notice of their intention to use a buggy, confirm that they are competent to use the buggy and have the appropriate insurance. A copy of the route to be followed will be given to them. All buggy users must ensure that their buggy is mechanically sound and sign the Safety Acknowledgement form

From time to time because of the state of the Course or the weather it may be necessary not to allow the use of buggies on all or part of the Course. Where such conditions arise the Club will review the situation on at least a twice daily basis, and the reasons for the decision will be recorded.

The Club will accept no responsibility for any loss or damage to a buggy, nor any loss or damage caused to any property by a buggy. The consumption of alcohol and/or the improper use of drugs is not permitted when using a ride-on buggy. Children must not be allowed to drive a ride-on buggy.

The Club reserves the right to refuse permission to use a ride-on buggy if the conditions of this policy are not fully complied with.
